CHANGE IS IN THE AIR AT OLIVER'S

After more than 19 years, the ownership and management of *Oliver's Restaurant* is about to change and the changes are exciting!

Many of the friendly faces who have served you for years will remain the same and some new faces will be joining them. Steve Limmer, owner and proprietor of one of south St. Louis' oldest family restaurants, *The Original Crusoe's* at Osceola and Compton, will become the new owner effective October 1st.

New ownership will also bring a slight name change—it will become *Oliver's Restaurant and Deli*...yes, a deli is coming! The transition will take place in September without any closures or interruptions in dining service. Most of the remodeling will be done during the weekends as a new bar area is constructed in the back banquet room and improvements are made in the kitchen. Bar patrons will soon enjoy a roomier indoor atmosphere immediately adjacent to the patio.

The current bar area will then be transformed into a neighborhood deli with convenient curbside parking for carry-outs. The new deli will be a convenient location for an early morning cup of gourmet coffee and a bakery item or a spot to quickly pickup a fresh deli sandwich for lunch.

Of course, full-service dining will continue in the main dining room with a new menu containing some great new entrees alongside many of your old *Oliver's* favorites.

During the transition, hours will be limited to weekdays from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. but will expand to a 6 a.m. opening when the deli is completed. Weekend hours will also return sometime in the future.

Stop in and introduce yourself to Steve and his crew and try out some of the new menu items. The restaurant will be available for holiday parties, so book your party now to ensure your choice of dates.
